We suggest that you keep the following in mind when finalizing the article for JSPS

Abstracts. We request that article has an abstract of around 150 words explaining its content succinctly.

Length. The essay should be between 7,000 to 10,000 words, including the notes.

Text format. Please submit your essay as a Word document.

Notes. Please use the Chicago Manual of Style as your guide: http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide.html. Please format the notes as endnotes to be followed by bibliography.

Bibliography. Please create an alphabetized bibliography. The format of each entry will be similar to that of the corresponding note, except that the author's last name comes first. If there are multiple entries for a single author, alphabetize those as well and make use of the 3-em dash, as described thus in the CMS: http://www.chicagomanualofstyle.org/tools_citationguide.html.

Illustrations. We welcome illustrations, but we request that you carefully judge whether or not they are essential to your essay. Illustrations should come in files that are independent of text along with a list of captions. You are responsible individually for securing the permission to produce an image if it is not your own—and to forward a copy of those documents, specifying world rights, in all languages and all media (print and e-book) to us.

Diacritics. From Issue 25 onward, the JSPS will follow a system of transcription the details of which will be provided soon
